Fat Hamster & KANG New is an electronic music duo based in South Korea that performs live sets.

They founded the independent label LetzRatz to release their own music and have been performing at various events and music festivals, including the International Environmental Film Festival, Zandari Festa, Block Party Music & Art Festival, as well as live venues in Seoul, Busan, Gwangju, and other cities.

They has also been actively performing overseas, including a successful tour in Japan in 2023.

Their music has been featured in the Top 100 tracks of Korean indie music webzine Platform Magazine for three consecutive years. And recently, they were featured in The Korea Times' list of 10 must-see Korean indie acts, so their performances are not only appreciated by audiences, but also by critics and other artists. Their live performances feature Fat Hamster's electronic music playing with heavy basslines and beautiful leads, along with KANG New's electronic percussion and unique vocal performance.



Fat Hamster is an electronica musician based in Seoul, South Korea. He produces bass heavy downtempo electronica with Synth wavy leads.

Fat Hamster's musical journey has been anything but short. Having studied classical and **contemporary music** at a university, the results of his musical exploration from the education are manifested in his music; counterpointing lead melodies, experimental percussion sounds, and the beats that incorporate mathematical calculations. He also used to be a frontman in an **alternative rock band** for many years. This experience has given him the ability to produce colorful beats that are both groovy and head-banging, and the stage persona to keep audiences engaged and excited.

With most recent EP [Nonviolent Communication], he has once again pushed his musical boundaries featuring and collaborating with artists and musicians from other genres such as Korean traditinal instrument 'Gayagume', meditation music, and trance music.

The web magazine mixmag Korea commented on this EP saying, "Fat Hamster's heavy basslines, colorful yet restrained synth arpeggios, and free drum beats that don't follow a single pattern are synergized with each of the unique featured artists."


KANG New is an electronica singer-songwriter based in Seoul, South Korea.

Playful, sometimes **geeky fun tracks**, and a variety of vocals that switch between singing, shouting, and narrating are KANG New's style.


